About These Guidelines

Using the enclosed styles consistently will strengthen perceptions of the Salvation Farms brand.

- Keep it simple!
- Themes: Organic, natural, warm, welcoming, strong, supportive
- A range of color allows design consistency while livening up individual pieces.
- Resist the urge to tweak it – consistency wins.

Colors

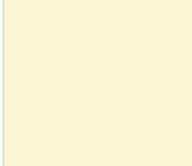
- Colors from the farm and garden.
- Use Sweet Corn, Carrot, and Soil to avoid a Christmas-y look.
- Don't pick colors from the square swatches below – use the values provided in text.
- Where possible, prefer the Hex (RGB) color.
- CMYK and Pantone colors are digital conversions that have been fine-tuned. Before committing to a print job, look at a Pantone book and check the proof. As a guide, perceptual descriptions follow some of the color names below.

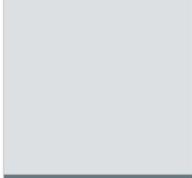
TINTS & ACCENTS

For subtle contrast or for readability (4.5:1 contrast is for WCAG/ADA accessibility).

COMBINATIONS

Take care to avoid text with insufficient contrast. These combos are good:

- Soil background with Light Sweet Corn text
- Kale background with Light Lettuce text
- Carrot background with white text
- Cabbage background with white text
- Light Lettuce background with Kale text
- Sweet Corn background with Soil text

Typography

All typefaces can be downloaded for free from Google Fonts for use in any medium.

- **Headlines:** [Aleo](#) (black/900): Contemporary slab serif, designed to pair with Lato. Colors: Soil preferred, Kale also OK
- **Secondary Headers:** [Geologica](#) (bold/700): Sturdy humanist-geometric typeface. Colors: Soil preferred, Dark Carrot or Dark lettuce also OK
- **Tertiary Headers:** Aleo (bold/700). Short headlines set in all caps with some letter spacing works well. Avoid all caps with longer headlines.
- **Text:** [Lato](#) (regular, bold, italic): A modern humanist typeface with semi-rounded details – serious but also warm and friendly. Also good for pull quotes. Colors: Black in print, dark gray online (#222222)

METHODS

Logo

Bold colors are complemented with the sturdiness of Aleo (black/900).

GUIDELINES

- **Clear space:** Avoid placing other elements too close to the logo (space equivalent to the height of the barn roof, or half the height of the artwork, would be good).
- **Stickers:** A white all-around margin (equivalent to the white space between the text and the artwork) would be good for stickers. Do not shrink the text relative to the artwork.
- **Reversed:** Make the text white when placing the logo on top of a photo or dark background color. Ensure there is sufficient color contrast for high text legibility.

STYLES

- **Stacked:** The primary preferred version of the logo, with the artwork above the text.
- **Horizontal:** Use when the logo is small (to avoid the text becoming too small), or where a horizontal orientation is necessary, such as websites or banners.
- **Square:** For social media profile image/avatar usage only, where the organization's name will always appear nearby.

FILE FORMATS

- **Original:** The original Adobe Illustrator files in RGB color. These should only be needed when editing the logo and should not be used directly. *Prefer the outlined type versions to avoid variations in text alignment.*
- **RGB (Online and MS Word):** SVG and PNG files with RGB colors. Prefer SVG if it is supported by the software or service you are using (like Microsoft Word).
- **Print:** Press-ready CMYK and Grayscale PDFs (editable in Illustrator). *Your print company can easily swap CMYK for Pantone if you are printing spot color inks.*
